The Glens Falls Area Youth Center offers a comprehensive Youth Services and Recreation Program designed to enhance the lives of disadvantaged youth ages 10-18. The Youth Center, founded in 1968, is the only teen drop-in facility of its kind in the area and is open throughout the year. Proceeds from the Golf Classic will provide meals for the teens who visit the Youth Center. The Center prepares 250 meals a week totaling 12,000+ meals a year.

The Greenwich Youth Center's purpose is to provide recreational, educational and other beneficial activities and programs for youth. The proceeds from the Golf Classic will be used to purchase equipment for the Center's new radio station including a sound system and music equipment.

The Troy Boys & Girls Club provides local and national programs to Club members ages 5-18 through an After-School Program, Teen Program and at Camp Barker, during summer camp. The majority of the children they serve are ethnically diverse from lower socio-economic backgrounds and often, single parent homes. The funds from the Golf Classic will be used for operating expenses, which may include scholarships, camp fees, membership fees, and program supplies. The club does not want to turn any child away.

For 39 years, **The Cohoes Community Center** has provided recreational, educational, vocational, and cultural programs for the City of Cohoes and ultimately the greater Capital Region. The Center is open to the public and provides a community gathering space for people of all ages. The proceeds for the Golf Classic will help to support an enhancement program for youth, ages 5 to 11, that enriches children's lives by keeping them physically active and exposes them to basic cooking and healthy eating habits. This special program will also allow youth to expand their knowledge of sports, team work, and cooperation and provide them with basic life skills.

The Saratoga Regional YMCA - Corinth Branch provides its community members with programs it needs most, such as youth-based activities, including Youth Karate, Teen Fit, free swimming lessons and afterschool care, as well as full access to a fitness area and Computer Café. Children, families, individuals and seniors all have a welcoming facility where they can workout, spend time together, and learn. The Corinth Branch will use their proceeds from the Golf Classic to help expand their Aerobics Studio and Fitness Area, allowing for additional participants in their Youth Karate ages 5 and up and their Teen Fit Programs ages 10 to 17.
