WHAT DOES HUDSON RIVER COMMUNITY CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and account balances
- checking account information and employment information
- mortgage rates and payments and payment history

When you are *no longer* our member, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons Hudson River Community Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

For our everyday business purposes – such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or to report to credit bureaus	Yes	No

What we do		
How does Hudson River Community Credit Union protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.	
How does Hudson River Community Credit Union collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you open an account or seek financial or tax advice make a wire transfer or apply for financing provide account information	
	We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.	
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State law and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. 	
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices apply to everyone on the account.	

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. ■ Our affiliates are Riverside Managed Services and HRCCU Insurance Agency LLC.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. - Hudson River Community Credit Union does not share with our nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our joint marketing partners include insurance companies.
